ISOP ISA 007	<b>Isoplexis isabelliana</b> A plant endemic to the Canary Islands. Flowers are large and bright orange. Grows best in a dry site and will tolerate coastal conditions.	Now	7	\$1.35

BUXU KOR 007	<b>Buxus microphylla var koreana</b> A dwarf variety differing in its spreading habit and dark green leaves. Ht 50cm. Origin Korea	Now	7	\$1.35
BUXU NOT 007	<b>Buxus sempervirens Notata</b> This is the main form planted for excellent edging box. The most frequently used Box for hedging since its introduction to NZ by the missionaries in 1830. Ht 75cm. Evergreen.	Now	7	\$1.35
