



### Enjoy life from your garden!

Welcome to our first Newsletter for 2019. Christmas and New Year have been a very busy time for us with the team completing our major stock take for the year ahead. With over 4,000 plant lines to stock take- it's a huge job! From the stock take and your pre-orders, we plan our production schedules and breeding programmes so we know which plants and how many to propagate, grow on and when they will be released. This process of a plant being developed and released for sale can take years! Pseudowintera Red Leopard, one of our flagship plants took 20 years!

It has certainly been dry over the break and some days, it's been hard to keep up with the watering. Here at the Nursery, to help plants cope with the heat we use mulch a lot to help retain moisture in the soil, suppress weeds and to keep the soil cool. Organic mulches like pea straw and peat/bark mixes also help improve soil fertility, as they slowly decompose. We will have pea straw available soon at \$12.99 a bale, or 5 bales for \$55. We also have a special blend of peat and bark mulch made to our own recipe- it's the mulch we use here at Blue Mountain Nurseries and it's available at \$8.99 a bag or \$79.99 a cubic metre (approx. a trailer load).

This month we have some lovely plants to share with you. For something a little different, try Lapageria, the Chilean Bell Flower. This rare twining climber is a handsome plant with glossy dark-green leathery foliage and long bell-shaped waxy flowers in tones of rose-red-white. Lapageria has a long flowering period with flowers in late summer through to late winter and sometimes, even early spring. It's an ideal climber for a mild, shady garden with a cool moist root run, acid to neutral soils and with protection from cold drying winds.

Also hailing from Chile, Francoa's are an attractive evergreen perennial plant that have been grown for many years as a cut flower crop and as a ground cover. Rosettes can often be furry with deeply lobbed leaves which are well designed to withstand dry and shaded growing conditions. This makes Francoa's perfect for a woodland type setting. Group planting in good soil and conditions extends the flowering period with bigger and more spectacular floral displays. Francoa will continue to flower throughout the summer until the first frosts of winter. Two new releases of Francoa are the pink 'Rose Bouquet' and the 'White Bouquet' bred for their larger flowers and longer, stronger flower stems.

We have a new crop of Bergenia Wanaka Wine that is looking good now and the Chocolate Cosmos are ready to flower with their sweet chocolatey scent. Pseudowintera Red Leopard and Limelight have grown well and their vibrant colour has developed and deepened over Christmas. The Eucryphia cordifolia are about to flower with white scented blooms. These are great food for bees and make a beautiful display in the garden.



# Lapageria rosea

Rose-crimson bell shaped flowers in summer and autumn on a wiry vine. Likes a cool

moist root run. Ht. 2m. Evergreen.

#### Francoapink or white

Large evergreen perennial with green furry compound leaves, large white or pink

flowers open from blush pink buds on 75cm spikes.

#### Leucothoe fontanesiana **Crimson Globe**

### **Calluna Annabel**



Heather. Upright spikes of dainty bell shaped rich double pink flower. Autumn flowering. A very good cut flower. Ht 40cm.

#### Campanula glomerata **Alba**



White flowers cover this compact perennial campanula. Grows well in containers or in a sunny garden. Ht 20cm

#### **Cosmos Chocolate**



Chocolate scented flowers. A summer flowering perennial for the front of a sunny border. Velvety dark flowers that are nearly black. Ht. 60cm.
