SKIM CHR 007	<b>Skimmia Cherry Red</b> Lovely form from Cherry Orchard with bright red berries	7
SKIM JFE 007	<b>Skimmia japonica Rogersii</b> Compact female clone with clusters of red berries throughout the winter months with scented white flowers in spring. Likes shade. Ht 1m. Evergreen.	7
