AZAR MIC 007	<b>Azara microphylla</b> Upright tree of green foliage and chocolate scented flowers in summer. Ht 3m. Evergreen.	7
BERB FAV 005	<b>Berberis Little Favourite</b> Bright purple red foliage and autumn colour. Very hardy. Ht 80cm. Deciduous.	7
BRUN MAC	<b>Brunnera macrophylla</b> Clumps of green leaves. Blue For Get Me Not like flowers in summer. Ht. 40cm.	7
BUXU KOR 007	<b>Buxus microphylla var koreana</b> A dwarf variety differing in its spreading habit and dark green leaves. Ht 50cm. Origin Korea	7
BUXU NOT 007	<b>Buxus sempervirens Notata</b> This is the main form planted for excellent edging box. The most frequently used Box for hedging since its introduction to NZ by the missionaries in 1830. Ht 75cm. Evergreen.	7

ABUT NAB 175	<b>Abutilon Nabob</b> Deep black/red flowers in summer on an upright shrub. Attracts the bell birds. Award of graden merit Royal Horticultural Society.(AGM). Ht1.5m	175
AGAP VAL 175	<b>Agapanthus Val</b> Dense heads of deep blue flowers in February. Very showy. Ideal cut flower and garden decoration. Plant in a sunny garden.Ht 1m Deciduous	175
ALOY TRIP 175	<b>Aloisia triphylla</b> A medium sized to large shrub with lanceolate lemon scented leaves normally in whorls of 3 .The tiny light purple flowers are profusely borne in terminal panicles , best grown against a warm wall	175
